# *Pastor's Introduction*

Announcing the good news of salvation through Jesus is our mission as a church. We have the privilege of telling family, coworkers, classmates, and friends about Jesus. In this past year we have had the opportunity to see our mission at work. Our Youth Missions team partnered with Good Neighbors Home Repair to provide warmer, drier, and safer homes for our neighbors as they shared the gospel in word and deed. We were reminded at last year's congregational meeting of the impact of global missions when we celebrated Harry Marshall's 100th birthday. He offers us a powerful example of a life committed to sharing the good news of forgiveness through Jesus.

We said goodbye in the fall to the Harr family as Tom became the Senior Pastor of Calvary Presbyterian Church in NJ. While our goodbyes were mixed with tears, we have been confronted with the mission of the church to reach our neighbors with the hope of the gospel. Pastor Jim and Pat Brown also offered an example to us as they gave their summer to interim ministry in Sydney, Nova Scotia. They shepherded a small congregation in their ministry of revitalization. They equipped and encouraged the church in reaching that local community with the gospel.

Our gospel mission continues. Ministry leaders and staff equip us and shape the strategies to reach others with the gospel. We gather in worship. We learn in Sunday School. We grow in community groups. We serve in ministry. We go with the gospel into our neighborhoods and around the globe.

# Evangelism & Outreach

## FAITH EXPLORED

Faith Explored is a seven-week introduction to Christianity course offered twice a year. Every week starts with a meal prepared and served by volunteers which provides an informal setting for participants to feel comfortable asking their questions. After the meal, Pastor Kevin gives a topical talk based on the Gospel of Mark, followed by small group discussions, and a period of open questions and answers. Throughout the program, participants are encouraged to ask any question they have related to God, the Bible, faith, and life.

It's a direct but engaging question, "Will you join me to find answers to life's biggest questions?"**

## COMMUNITY EVENTS

We intentionally plan church-wide events designed to deliberately engage our community: Vacation Bible School, Pioneer Clubs, the Easter Egg Hunt, and Fall Fest. In the spring of 2018 we also sponsored a baseball team with four players and three coaches from Faith.

**At least half of attendees at these events are not members of Faith, providing us opportunities to cultivate relationships with people from our surrounding community.**

## MARY CAMPBELL CENTER WORSHIP SERVICE

The Mary Campbell Center is a long-term residential care facility for adults with disabilities located less than two miles from Faith. We lead worship services regularly on Sunday afternoons for the residents.

MISSIONS

In 2018 we were able to invest more than \$26,000 in missions efforts on top of the \$128,001 budgeted for the year from our designated fund.

The Missions Committee is an exciting committee to be involved with. We get to see firsthand, the ministry updates from our missionaries all around the world. It provides a window into different cultures, and also shows how God is working everywhere, all the time. We get to provide for their financial and prayer needs. As we give, we are able to see the fruits of the missionaries’ labor in the mission field, through the Holy Spirit. For anyone interested in short term or long term missions, MTW has several opportunities in which to serve. If you go to [www.mtw.org](http://www.mtw.org) you will find weekly, monthly, and yearly trips.
